- 5. The final result will be calculated by taking 10% weightage of the Periodic Test + 10% weightage of Note Book, Subject Enrichment Activities and Attendance + 80% weightage of Half Yearly and Final Year. (For Class 6th to 8th only)

PROMOTION POLICY / RULES

1. In order to be declared as 'Passed', a candidate shall obtain not less than 33% marks in each of the five subjects separately and in aggregate.
